

# Prehistory



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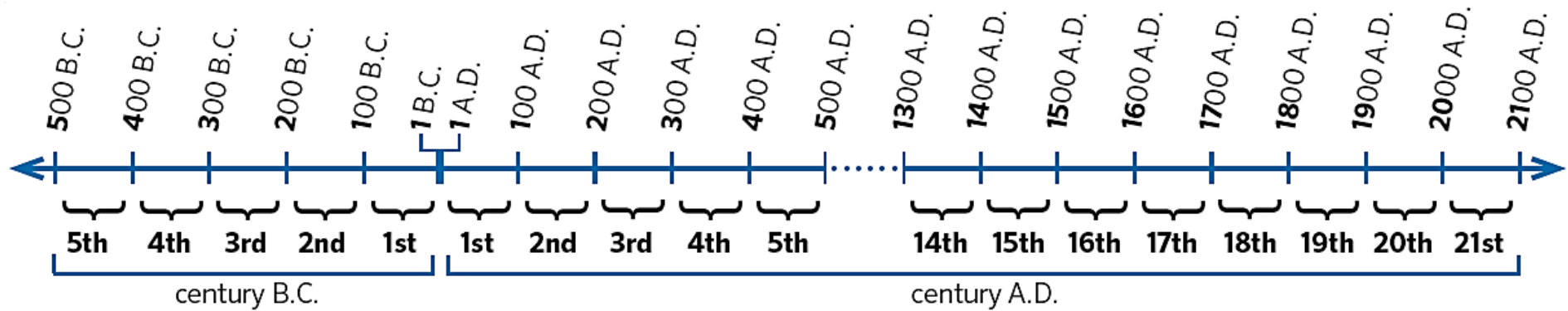


**The Modern Age** started when the French Revolution happened.



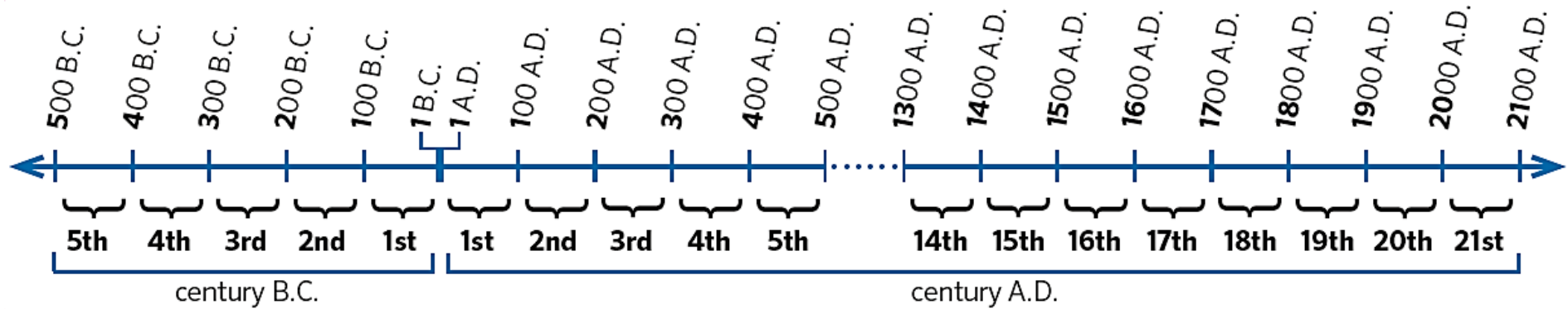


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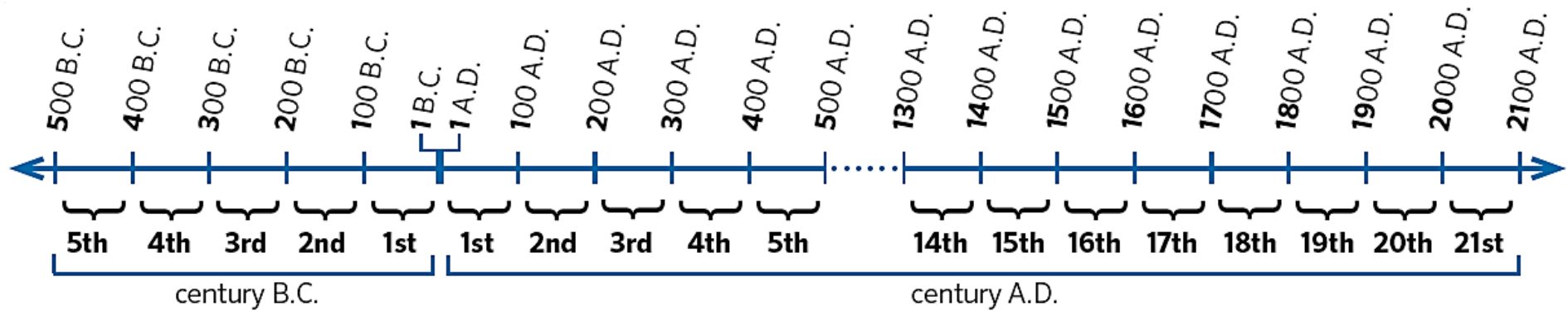
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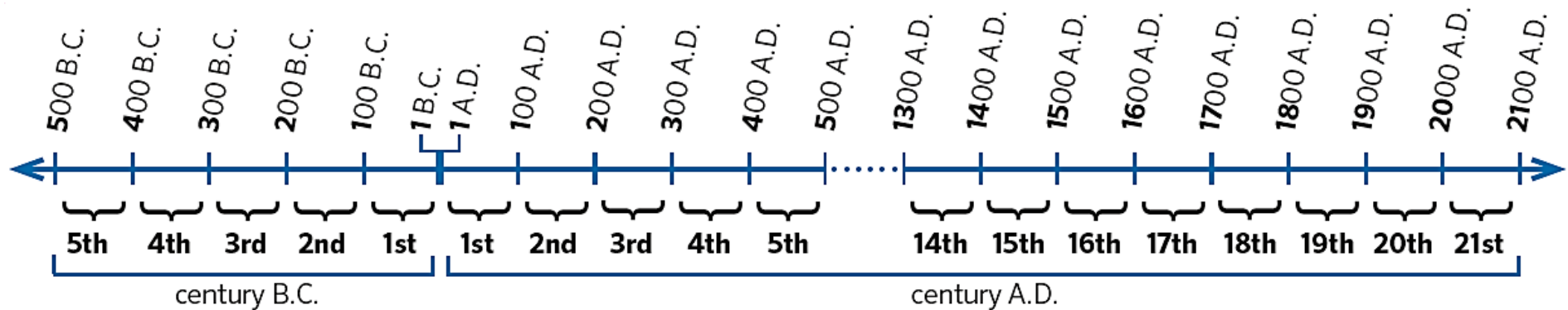


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We count the years starting from the year 1. This was when Jesus Christ was born. Years and centuries after Jesus was born are called **A.D.** and years and centuries before Jesus was born are called **B.C.**



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Prehistory is divided into two periods: The Stone Age and the Bronze and Iron Ages. The **Stone Age** emerged when the first humans appeared and began to use tools. The first part of the Stone Age is the **Paleolithic Period**, and the second part is the **Neolithic Period**.

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They also wore clothes made of animal skins.

Paleolithic people made tools from stone, wood and animal bones.

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Some people were artisans and others were farmers. They started to exchange the products they made and the crops they cultivated. This was the beginning of **trade**.



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They also made **figurines** out of stone and bones.





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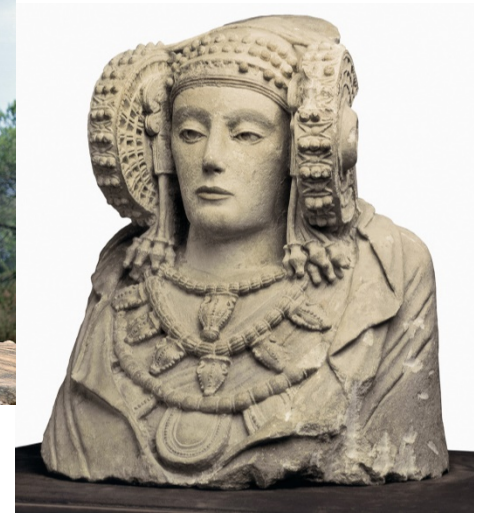


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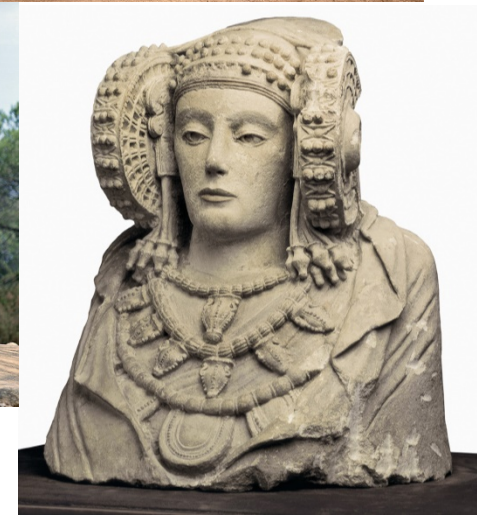
There was more trade than before, and more jobs that people could do, such as metalworkers, soldiers and traders.

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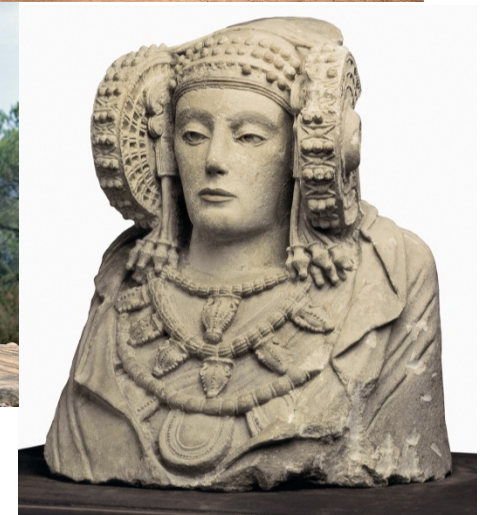
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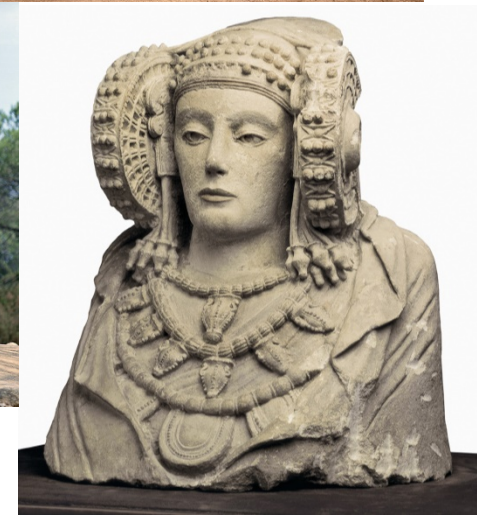


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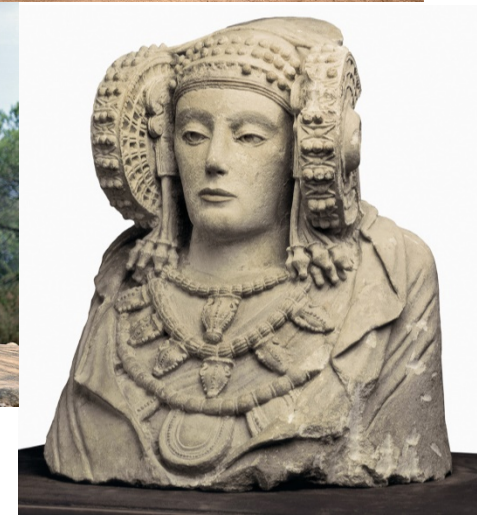


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
